


Position paper

¿Qué es la hoja de postura?

A position paper is a document that reflects the relation and the position of a country regarding the defined topic to be treated on the designated committee. Its objective is to help the delegate undertake a process of development and organization of main ideas and proposal.



¿Qué es la hoja de postura?



It is composed by three main documents.

- Generalities Page (General facts and data about the country)
- Position Paper
- References

How to make a Position paper?

1. Research

2. Delimitate

First, you should conduct your research about the topic of the committee that was assigned to you. You will read about the situation of the problem worldwide.

After reading and having a worldwide context of the problem, you should focus on what is the position of your country in that specific topic in the UN.

Generalities Page

- Total Area
- Territorial boundaries:
- Coasts
- Population
- Ethnic distribution
- Religion(s)
- Language(s)

- Governmental system
- Head of state
- Legal System
- Election System
- Brief history
- Organizations in which the country is an active member

Position Paper - Heading

The left side of the heading contains the country's flag, followed by:

- The delegate's full name.
- Committee's full name.
- Official name of the country.
- Topic.



Position Paper Development

The development is comprised by three paragraphs in which the topic is briefly disclosed, along with a description of the country's involvement and an introduction to possible solutions to the conflict in question.

Characteristics

- In accordance with the country's position regarding the conflict
- Written in third person.
- Academic language.
- Citations in APA format

Structure (3 Paragraphs)

- Introduction, ¿What's happening? ¿how is your country being affected?
- What actions has your country taken regarding the problem nationally and internationally?
- New, creative and realistic solutions to the problem
